ST ANNE'S: 75 YEARS A PARISH

This weekend St Anne's completes for 75 years as a parish. Thanks be to God! And Congratulations St Anne's. Back in 1947, the first parish priest (Fr Michael O'Carroll) was appointed and our parish established. Until then Manurewa had been part of Papakura Parish, and before that part of Otahuhu. By 1947 the population here warranted a parish of our own. An outlying chapel (St Anne's),



built in 1927, was made the parish church. It stood on the corner of Russell Road and Weymouth Road opposite St Luke's Anglican Church which is still there. The two churches were similar in size and style. St Anne's School was also there. We relocated to the current more spacious site 21 Feb 1988. For more info there is a booklet for sale in the parish office. Congratulations St Anne's. God bless all who have built up our community. And Eternal Life to those who have gone on ahead of us.

PILGRIMAGE ICON OF MARY VISITS ST ANNE'S



This beautiful Icon of Mary will be visiting St Anne's from this Wed (9 Feb) till Fri 18 Feb. St Anne's has been chosen as a 'resting place' on the journey to Wellington. We will receive her with a few prayers at 7pm on Wed evening and bring her from the car park into the church. Come if you can. I hope that she can be unpacked and put up in the sanctuary during the prayers. Depending on how many attend, we can pray in the courtyard as she is put in place. Bring your mask. This Icon comes to us from the parish of Onehunga (Our Lady of the Assumption) who have had a 'turn' hosting her. The image has been commissioned especially for Aotearoa New Zealand to be placed permanently at St Mary of the Angels (Wellington). That church was named as the National Shrine of Mary in August 2021.
