SO WHO IS OUR BISHOP?

We pray for our Bishop Stephen and his Assistant Michael." These words we heard for the first time in the Eucharistic Prayer at Mass on December 18 last year – after 27 years

"of praying for Bishop Patrick (Dunn). Just the night before, the priests of Auckland had received a confidential email to include this new name at Mass on the following day. The letter added that Pope Francis was going to name Stephen Lowe as our new Bishop at that midnight NZ time (midday Rome time). Bishop Pat had a replacement and due to ailing health (his eyes) was able to step aside immediately.



So who is this new bishop of Auckland? Bishop Stephen Lowe was born in Hokitika, worked as a priest in the Christchurch Diocese, gained an STL degree in Rome and from 2008-14 got to know Auckland as Director of Formation at Holy Cross Seminary Ponsonby. I was fortunate to work alongside him at that time as the boss of the Marist <u>Seminary just around</u> the corner.



Steve was a most hospitable neighbour, an inclusive colleague and a hard-working generous priest. A very good man for a Bishop – which he became for Hamilton and now for Auckland.

Covid has restricted his getting out and about, but when he does come to St Anne's, we'll recognize him from this photo! This is the man we pray for. Welcome Bishop Stephen!
