THE PRIMACY OF PETER

The main reason for the Gospel today. John 21:1-19, is to recount the appearance of Jesus and stress the Primacy by Jesus on Peter. When Jesus first meets Peter he changes his name to Cephas meaning Rock. Later in Caesarea Philippi he says "You are (Peter) Rock and upon this Rock I will build my Church . . .and I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven" (Matt. 16:18-19).

In the Gospel today Jesus says that Peter will be the **New Shepherd**, the keeper and head of Christ's Church.

This position of authority was recognized by his fellow Apostles and by the first Christians, as is evident in almost every page of the Acts of the Apostles.

Since then the successor of Peter, is seen as the living representative of Christ, who is always the occupant of the See of Rome, the bishopric held by Peter, when he was martyred for the faith. History is witness to this as will be events that turn out in Rome in these days as the Conclave elects a new pope.

In 3:7-15 of Johns Gospel, Jesus said referring to the Spirit.

"The wind blows where it wills, and you hear the sound on it. But you do not know where it comes from or where it goes".

We with the cardinals and the whole Church need to invite the Spirit to blow on the cardinals as they discern and on that person who will be elected the next pope.



Or see a man about a dog, as goes the saying. But so many people?


I don't doubt that there are understandable reasons for leaving early if they be true.
