## KEEP IT SIMPLE "TRINITY THE GOD WHO GIVES HIMSELF TO US"

For over 2,000 years, great thinkers have been trying to explain the diagram on the right, which in words say that God is one being but exists in three separate ways: God the Father, God the Son (Jesus) and the Holy Spirit. Each of these "persons" is fully God, but **they work together and are not separate** from each other.

But Jesus invites us to see this mystery, not with deep thoughts and philosophy, but the simple fact that we are in relationship with God.

God is Love, and He gives Himself to us. What makes us tick is that spark of God, of divine love, in our human DNA.

The biblical concept of humanity being made in the image and likeness of God is primarily found in Genesis 1:27:

**"So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them."**

Jesus, who becomes human, is able to reveal to us in a human way that our God is a Father who understands us, loves us and forgives us like no one else.

Jesus Himself in a human way, teaches us and invites us to trust him as the Son of God, and what he says about the Father.

Jesus also tells us that the Spirit within us, within our DNA, is from the Spirit of God, whose power we have.

This Spirit is the love of God, the breath shared by the Father and his Son Jesus, the strength, the impulse, and the vital energy that makes us his witnesses and collaborators in the service of the great project of the Holy Trinity.

Our destiny in life is to walk to the Father who loves us and wants all that is good for us. We follow our destiny doing this through Jesus who takes us by the hand and shows us the way with the energy we get to do this from the same Spirit of love between the Father and Son, which is in our DNA.
