Upcoming work on the electricity network in your area

Vector owns and operates electricity and gas networks across the greater Auckland region. We're constantly working to ensure they are safe and reliable.

We'd like to let you know about upcoming work we are doing to upgrade electrical equipment in your area. This work will take place in phases and is scheduled to start in **March 2026**, continuing through to approximately the **end of July 2026**.

The phases of the project involves excavation to install new underground ducts, followed by temporary surface reinstatement. Once this stage is complete, electrical installation will begin. Final surface reinstatement is scheduled for 2027, and we'll keep you updated as we go.

Some stages of the work may require planned power outages. If outages are required, affected customers will be notified in advance.

We appreciate this is a significant period of work to have in your area and are committed to completing it as efficiently and safely as possible. We have coordinated with Auckland Transport to minimise disruption to the community where we can. Measures to reduce impacts include maintaining access to homes, businesses and Holy Trinity School, making temporary road layout changes to maintain traffic flow, and installing signage boards.

Work will take place on the following roads (which will be signposted):

- **Airfield Road** – Road closure from Porchester Road to Mill Road continuing to 31st July – access for Business, residents and the school will be maintained.
- **Intersection of Mill Road and Airfield Road (roundabout)** – Full four-way road closure during Easter and Anzac Weekends.

During the work period you can expect the following:

- **Excavation work** – There will be excavations in the roadway which will be barriered off for safety. Where required, mats will be used to reduce noise and vibration from construction equipment.
- **Work hours** – Monday to Sunday, 7am–7pm. Some late evening work (until 10pm) may occur for critical tasks.
- **Noise management** – Noisy activities (e.g., concrete cutting, hydro-vacuuming) will be limited to 8am–6pm as much as possible.
- **Property access** – Property access may be limited at times. Affected residents will be notified in advance.
- **Power outages** – If planned power outages are required to safely complete parts of the work, affected customers will receive advance notice.
