Hello,

An update on the electricity network project in your area

As promised, we'd like to keep you updated on the project as we work through your area and take this opportunity to thank you for your patience so far.

As a reminder, we're upgrading electrical equipment near you until approximately **mid- August 2026**. The work involves excavation to install new underground ducts, electrical cable installation, overhead pole and cabling, followed by temporary surface reinstatement. Final surface reinstatement is scheduled for 2027 - we'll keep you updated.

Once again, we appreciate this is a significant period to be in your area. We're committed to completing it as efficiently and safely as possible. We continue to work with Auckland Transport to minimise disruption where we can. Measures to reduce impacts include maintaining access to homes, businesses and Holy Trinity School, making temporary road layout changes to maintain traffic flow, and installing signage boards.

Work will take place on the following roads (which will be signposted). Please see the reverse side of this letter for a map of the work zones

- **Airfield Road**
 - Road closure from Porchester Road to Mill Road continuing to 31st July – access for business, residents and the school will be maintained.
 - Stop/Go Traffic lights will be installed on Airfield Road from Porchester Road to Mill Road from late-June to late-July to assist traffic flow through the road closure
 - Oneway detour from Mill Road to Mullins Road from approximately Tuesday 19 May to Wednesday 1 June
- **Mill Rd (Intersection of Airfield Road)**
 - One way detour (for north bound traffic) in weekends from 27th June till 26th July for 3-4 weekends. Traffic will be detoured west on to Airfield Rd (the traffic lights will not be operational in weekends as it will be oneway only)
- **Mill Rd and Airfield Rd (night and day works)**
 - A mixture of Stop/Go's along Airfield Road between Mill Road and Mullins Road, and the intersection of Mill Road and Airfield Road and one-way detour (as above) on Mill Road (intersection of Airfield Rd) - work dates from 4th July to 9th August

During the work period you can expect the following:

- **Excavation work** – There will be excavations in the roadway which will be barriered off for safety. Where required, mats will be used to reduce noise and vibration from construction equipment.
- **Work hours** – Monday to Sunday, 7am–7pm. Some late evening work (until 10pm) may occur for critical tasks.
- **Night Works** – Monday to Sunday, 8pm–5am
- **Noise management** – Noisy activities (e.g., concrete cutting, hydro-vacuuming) will be limited to 8am–6pm as much as possible.
- **Property access** – Property access may be limited at times. Affected residents will be notified early.
- **Power outages** – If planned power outages are required to safely complete parts of the work, affected customers will receive advance notice.

Brown Phase
Location: Airfield Rd
Timing: Continuing from March to July 2026
Traffic Flow: Airfield Road from Porchester to Mill Road will be closed. Detours will be in place

Green Phase
Location: Airfield Rd
Timing: Continuing from End June to Mid-July 2026
Traffic Flow: Stop/Go traffic lights in place at these two location with Airfield Rd from Porchester to Mill Rd will be closed. Detours will be in place

Orange Phase
Location: Intersection of Mill Road and Airfield Road and Airfield Road from Mill Road to 269 Airfield Rd
Timing: 27 May till 9 August 2026
Traffic Flow:
Mill Road (Intersection of Airfield Road)

- One way detour (for north bound traffic) in weekends from 27 June - 26 July for 3-4 weekends. Traffic will be detoured west on to Airfield Rd (the traffic lights will not be operational in weekends as it will be one way only)

Mill Road and Airfield Road night & day work

- Mixture of Stop/Go's along Airfield Road between Mill Road and Mullins Road, and the intersection of Mill Road & Airfield Road. And oneway detour (as above) on Mill Road (intersection of Airfield Road). Work dates from 4 July - 9 August



Red Phase
Location: Airfield Road (Mill Road to Mullins Road)
Timing: 19 May to 1 June 2026
Traffic Flow: Oneway Detour – Traffic cannot exit Airfield Road on to Mill Road. Detours in place

Please note - when we are working directly outside of your property driveway access will be restricted from 7am to 7pm

Our Traffic Control staff will assist you with access during these times. We request your patience during this time as we complete the work as fast as possible

Note - detour routes will be in place during all phases. Please follow the sign posted detours. If unsure, please ask one of our friendly crew on-site and they'll assist you
