An update on the electricity network project in your area

As promised, we'd like to keep you updated on the project as we work through your area and take this opportunity to thank you for your patience so far.

As a reminder, we're upgrading electrical equipment near you until approximately **end of September 2026**. The work has involved excavation to install new underground ducts, electrical cable installation, overhead pole and cabling, followed by temporary surface reinstatement. We are now in the final phase for duct testing and minor electrical works.

Final surface reinstatement is scheduled for 2027 - we'll keep you updated.

Once again, we appreciate this is a significant period to be in your area. We're committed to completing it as efficiently and safely as possible. We continue to work with Auckland Transport to minimise disruption where we can. Measures to reduce impacts include maintaining two-way traffic past all work areas, and maintaining access to homes, businesses and Holy Trinity School.

Work will take place on the following roads (which will be signposted). Please see the reverse side of this letter for a map of the work zones

- **Airfield Road**
 - Two-way traffic with isolated work zones as shown on the map on the reverse side
- **Mill Rd (Intersection of Airfield Road)**
 - Two-way traffic with isolated work zones as shown on the map on the reverse side

During the work period you can expect the following:

- **Excavation work** – There will be minor excavations on the edge of the roadway which will be barriered off for safety. Where required, mats will be used to reduce noise from construction equipment.
- **Work hours** – Monday to Sunday, 7am–7pm. Some late evening work (until 10pm) may occur for critical tasks.
- **Noise management** – Noisy activities (e.g., concrete cutting, hydro-vacuuming) will be limited to 8am–6pm as much as possible.
- **Property access** – Property access will be maintained at all times.
- **Power outages** – If planned power outages are required to safely complete parts of the work, affected customers will receive advance notice.
